The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.49 dated 19.05.2018, under Sections 376, 511, 323 of Indian Penal Code (Sections 452, 354, 354-A, 354-B, 354-D of IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Moga, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein contends that the petitioner was taken into custody in the aforesaid FIR on 19.05.2018. It is submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is also contended that investigation in the matter is complete and the challan has been presented and conclusion of trial will take sufficient time, therefore, the petitioner is entitled to be enlarged on bail.

Per contra, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent-State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, opposes the grant of regular bail to the petitioner, however, does not dispute the fact that investigation in the matter is complete and challan has been presented.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since, the trial is likely to take some time and in view of the facts that the petitioner herein has been in custody since 19.05.2018 and that investigation is complete and the challan has been presented, no useful purpose would be served in keeping the petitioner behind bars. At this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
