LISA GILL, J.

Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 0008 dated 09.01.2017 under Sections 452, 354A IPC and Section 8 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 registered at Police Station Ellenabad, District Sirsa.

It is submitted that the petitioner was afforded the concession of bail pending trial on 14.03.2017 by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sirsa. He regularly appeared before the learned trial Court but on 21.10.2017 he could not appear as a wrong date was noted. Due to this reason neither the petitioner nor his counsel were present. The petitioner undertakes to appear on each and every date fixed before the learned trial Court and not misuse the concession of anticipatory bail, if confirmed. He has appeared before the learned trial Court pursuant to order dated 28.11.2017 passed by this Court. It is, thus, prayed that this petition be allowed.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Rajinder, verifies that the petitioner has appeared before the learned trial Court and is not involved in any other criminal case.

Keeping in view the peculiar facts and circumstances noted above but without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, it is considered just and expedient to allow this petition.

Consequently, interim bail afforded to the petitioner by the learned trial Court pursuant to order dated 28.11.2017 be made absolute subject to his furnishing fresh bail bonds and surety to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
