RAJAN GUPTA J.

This is a petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in a case registered against the petitioner vide FIR No. 965 dated 07.09.2015 under sections 406, 420, 120B, 506 IPC at Police Station Hissar district Hissar.

Petitioner is stated to be in custody for considerable period. It has been urged before the court that dispute between complainant and petitioner is primarily civil in nature. Conclusion of proceedings may take long time to conclude. Besides, petitioner has been granted the concession of bail in other cases exactly similar in nature. Thus, he deserves to be enlarged on bail.

Aforesaid contentions remain uncontroverted.

Keeping in view the contentions made before this court and the period of incarceration, I am of the considered view that no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner in custody any longer.

Accordingly, petition is allowed and petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail to the satisfaction of Trial court/Duty Magistrate subject to such terms and condition(s) as it may deem fit to impose.
