RAMENDRA JAIN, J. (ORAL)

1. Through this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for quashing FIR No. 145 dated 26.04.2014 under Sections 294 & 506 of the IPC at Police Station Model Town District Rewari (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 08.11.2017 (Annexure P-2) effected between the parties.

2. Vide orders dated 28.11.2017, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court, to furnish a report qua veracity of the compromise.

3. Consequently, parties appeared before the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rewari and got recorded their statements qua compromise on 08.01.2018. Report from the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rewari, vide letter No.104 dated 10.01.2018, duly forwarded by

learned District and Sessions Judge, Rewari, vide letter No. 313, Dated, Rewari the 10.01.2018, has been received. According to the report of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rewari, the compromise is genuine, voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

4. In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, this petition is allowed and the aforesaid FIR No. 145 dated 26.04.2014 under Sections 294 & 506 of the IPC at Police Station Model Town District Rewari (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, qua the petitioner is quashed, subject to payment of costs of Rs. 10,000/-, out of which Rs. 4,000/- shall be deposited with the Bar Association of Punjab and Haryana, High Court, Rs. 1000/- with the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana and Rs. 5,000/- with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Legal Services Committee, within two weeks from today, failing which this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.
