ANITA CHAUDHRY, J

Petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.627 dated 04.10.2018 registered under Sections 498-A, 307, 506 read with Section 34 IPC at Police Station City Sirsa, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is the mother-in-law and she is in custody since 21.07.2018 and challan has been presented. Counsel submits that the allegations against the petitioner are that she had poured oil on the daughter-in-law whereas the husband had lit the fire and the MLR is available which would show the burn injuries on the left thigh and leg and the burns were superficial and the extent of injury is 18%. The counsel further submits that the couple were living separately in a rented accommodation but had come to stay with the mother-in-law, who is a widow only ten days ago.

Investigation is over. Challan has already been presented.

The trial would take time. Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing surety and adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
