Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are at threat at the hands of respondents no.4 to 8 because despite a compromise having been reached between the parties, a copy of which has been annexed as Annexure P-2 with the petition, the said respondents are now resiling from it and threatening the petitioners (as contended). The petitioners are also stated to have made a representation to the SSP, Barnala, i.e. respondent no.2, in respect of their grievance.

Consequently, without making any comment whatsoever on the aforesaid contention, including as to whether it was the petitioners or the aforesaid respondents who resiled from any compromise, which would be a matter to be gone into, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2, i.e. the SSP, Barnala, to go into the matter and to take a decision as per law, within a period of 1 month from today, duly ensuring that the lives and liberty of all sides are protected.
