Petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.27 dated 15.3.2017 registered under Sections 406, 420 and 506 IPC at Police Station Division No.4, Jalandhar.

On 2.12.2017, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioners seek anticipatory bail in their second attempt on the basis of changed circumstances in which the petitioners have arranged

the amount in question and they wish to pay the same to the complainant. Six demand drafts amounting to Rs.10.50 lakhs have been handed over to the complainant, who is present in person. The photostat copies of same have been attached with the revision petition.

Notice of motion for 15.01.2018.

Mr. Lekh Raj Sharma, Advocate, who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the complainant. In the meanwhile, petitioners are directed to appear before the Investigating Officer to join investigation on 08.12.2017 and in the event of their arrest, they shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioners shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Thereafter, vide order dated 22.12.2017, date of appearance of the petitioners before the Investigating Officer was extended to 13.1.2018.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Amarjit Singh, submitted that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid, interim orders dated 2.12.2017

and 22.12.2017 are made absolute. However, petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Officer.

Petition stands disposed of.
