ANITA CHAUDHRY, J

Petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.146 dated 04.10.2017 registered under Sections 363/366-A, 328, 205 IPC and Section 8 of POCSO Act, 2012, at Police Station Sector-37, Gurugram, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody for over 10 months and the prosecutrix has been examined. The counsel submits that though the victim has given her age to be 16 but she was earlier married and she has not supported the prosecution story and had also refused her medical. The counsel refers to the statement Annexure P-1 and the affidavit given by the mother.

The prosecutrix has been examined by the trial Court and the victim has not supported the prosecution version.

The trial would take time. Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing surety and adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
