This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.172 dated 29.09.2016, under Section 306 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Khanna, District Khanna.

On 30.11.2017, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a driver by profession and was not aware of the date on which he had to appear before the Court of Sessions after commitment of challan. His absence was not intentional.

Notice of motion for 08.02.2018.

Petitioner is directed to surrender before the

concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate, within two weeks and on his appearance, he shall be released on interim bail, till the next date, on his furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate."

Learned State counsel upon instructions from HC Harmeet Singh informs the Court that the petitioner had since put in appearance before the trial Court on 18.12.2017 and was admitted to interim bail upon having furnished requisite bail bonds/surety bonds.

In view of the above and coupled with the fact that the petitioner has already joined trial proceedings, prayer made in the petition is accepted.

Order dated 30.11.2017, passed by this Court is made absolute.
