By this petition, quashing of FIR No.281, dated 15.12.2015, is sought, registered against the petitioners at Police Station City Jagraon, District Ludhiana Rural, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 406/120-B IPC, on the basis of a compromise arrived at between the petitioners (accused) and respondent no.2, with respondent no.2, being the complainant.

Vide an order of this Court dated 29.11.2017, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded, in terms of the compromise.

Pursuant to the aforesaid order, the report of the learned SDJM, Jagraon, has been received, to the effect that the statement of the complainant in the FIR, i.e. respondent no.2, as also of the petitioners have been recorded

in terms of the compromise arrived at between the parties, a copy of which is annexed as Annexure P-2 with the petition, with the complainant having stated that he has compromised the matter voluntarily with the petitioners and has no objection to the FIR being quashed.

As per the assessment of the learned Magistrate, the compromise between the parties is genuine and without any pressure and coercion.

Consequently, the petition is allowed and FIR No.281, dated 15.12.2015, registered against the petitioners at Police Station City Jagraon, District Ludhiana Rural, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 406/120-B of the IPC, alongwith all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
