ANITA CHAUDHRY, J

Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.587 dated 02.07.2018 registered under Sections 304-B, 34 IPC (Section 304-B IPC has been deleted and Section 306 IPC has been added) at Police Station Model Town, District Panipat.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the marriage took place in 2017 and the wife had committed suicide and there are no injury in the PMR and the compromise has been effected.

Counsel for the petitioner has placed on record another application given by Sukhbir and an affidavit sworn by Sudesh wife of Sukhbir.

The daughter of the complainant had died an unnatural death in the matrimonial home within a year of the marriage. The allegations of harassment on account of dowry were levelled.

The petitioner has placed on record an application which shows that the complainant had given another application but there is no date on this application nor it is mentioned whether it was handed over to the police where different version is now stated. It appears that the petitioner has prevailed upon the complainant side and it amounts to tampering.

No case for anticipatory bail is made out.

Petition is dismissed.
