At the outset, learned counsel for respondent No. 2 submits that the matter has been compromised in between the parties and he has no objection, in acceptance of this petition and quashing FIR No. 139 dated 06.07.2017 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 452, 323, 427, 506, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Jandiala, Amritsar (Rural) and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Considering no objection of respondent No. 2-complainant in quashing the aforesaid FIR and the fact that the compromise will bring

harmony and peace in relations between the parties, this petition is allowed. Consequently, the aforesaid FIR No. 139 dated 06.07.2017 (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, qua the petitioners are quashed, subject to payment of costs of ₹10,000/-, out of which ₹7,000/- shall be deposited with the High Court Legal Service Committee and ₹3,000/- with Bar Association, Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh, within a period of two weeks' from today, failing which this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.
