This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Sections 392, 394, 397, 449, 120-B IPC and Sections 25/54/59 Arms Act at Police Station City Sirsa, District Sirsa, vide FIR No.392 dated 24.05.2017.

Petitioner is in custody since 30.5.2017. Trial is in progress and seven witnesses have already been examined. Trial may still take some time to conclude. So, no useful purpose will be served by detaining the petitioner in custody any longer. Thus, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Sirsa.
