Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 28.11.2017, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has cooperated.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 states that recovery is to be effected.

Learned State counsel informs that after the last date, four photographs were handed over by the complainant but it did not show that any article had been handed over at the time of marriage. There is a dispute with respect to the Scooter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the Scooter was taken on loan by the petitioner.

The complainant will have to prove all the allegations made, at the time of trial.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 28.11.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
