In the present petition, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail under the provision of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.278 dated 09.08.2018 under Sections 420, 336 IPC and Section 7 of Essential Commodities Act, 1955, registered at Police Station Div.No.5, District Ludhiana.

2. Allegations against the petitioner are that he is also involved in illegal transmitting of gas from one cylinder to another cylinder in order to earn profit with reference to commercial and domestic categorized gas filling. Petitioner's name has been cropped up on the arrest of one Sarfrazand Sushil who were caught while doing illegal activities with reference to transmitting gas and seizure of gas kit and 30 cylinders.

3. Co-accused Munish Kumar who has approached this court seeking anticipatory bail, his bail has been rejected while passing detailed order on 26.09.2018. Whereas the petitioner is main accused as is evident from FIR. Thus, in terms of the order dated 26.09.2018 passed in the case CRM-M-37263-2018 titled as ***Munish Kumar versus State of Punjab***, petitioner has not made out a case. Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
