Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 158 dated 08.08.2018 under Sections 21 and 29 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar.

In Para No. 12 of the petition, which is supported by an affidavit, it was specifically stated that the petitioner was not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Krishan Lal, submits that the petitioner is involved in another case i.e. FIR No. 277 dated 24.09.2017 under Sections 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Kotwali, District Kapurthala. He further submits that though the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 17.10.2018, has joined the investigation, however, she is the main accused as during investigation it has come against her from statement of co-accused, namely, Davinderpal Singh @ Shinda, that he has purchased the narcotics from her.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has concealed the factum of her involvement in another FIR and also in view of the fact that the same is opposed by the learned State counsel being a habitual offender, I find no ground to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
