This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to direct respondents No.4 and 5 not to harass the petitioner and his family members at the instance of respondents No.6 to 13.

It has been submitted that respondent No.4-Superintendent of Police (D), Bathinda is entrusted with the investigation and he is calling the petitioner and pressurizing him not to proceed with the civil suit filed by him.

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the concerned authorities to consider and decide representation (Annexure P-4) in a time bound manner.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to Director General of Police, Chandigarh respondents No.2 to consider and decide representation (Annexure P-4) within a period of 60 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

The matter in this case be got inquired by a police officer not

below the rank of Deputy Inspector General of Police.

If the presence of the petitioner is required by the police in connection with any investigation, then he may be called with prior permission to the Area Magistrate.
