The petitioner is aggrieved by order dated 11.09.2018 (Annexure P-6), whereby the trial Court has refused to re-call PW-1 to PW-3 for cross-examination.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on the date the aforementioned witnesses were examined, the petitioner was present but the counsel was unable to attend the Court due to his ill health. By passing the impugned order, the rights of the petitioners are being prejudiced.

Notice of motion.

Mr. R.S. Bains, DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Let two copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to seek any response to the petition.

Thus the impugned order dated 11.09.2018 (Annexure P-6) is set aside and the trial Court is directed to grant one opportunity to the petitioner to cross-examine PW-1 to PW-3.

The petition is disposed of.
