This Court had made order dated 31.07.2017 in this petition for rehearing, looking to the peculiar facts of the case and the delay in contesting this revision petition. This Court had made order asking the trial Court to complete the trial within stipulated period of six months. Thereafter, the learned counsel for the State of Punjab invited my attention to the fact that the petition was disposed of on 31.07.2017 without deciding CM No.18949 of 2011 for condonation of delay. Accordingly, the impugned order was recalled and the matter was posted for condonation of delay which was duly condoned on 28.09.2017. That is how the matter has again come up for disposal on merits.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the parties for quite some time I do not think that there is any reason to disturb the order dated 31.07.2017 passed by this Court finally deciding the case.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that one of the accused, who was discharged, has also died and there is only one person now remaining. Apart from that, out of 35 witnesses 29 witnesses have been examined.

In that view of the matter, order dated 31.07.2017 passed by this Court, stands confirmed. The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
