C.M. is allowed subject to just exceptions. The interim/zimni orders passed by the trial Court as Annexure A-1 (Colly.) are taken on record.

CRM-M-45166-2017

Petitioners have approached this Court for grant of anticipatory bail.

A perusal of the zimni orders, which have been placed on record, clearly indicates that the petitioners have not been appearing before the Court despite having been duly served and the proceedings for initiating proclamation under Section 82 of the Code of Criminal Procedure stand initiated. The order dated 06.01.2018 indicates that the case has been

adjourned for 06.02.2018 to await the presence of the accused prior to issuance of proclamation as 30 days had not been elapsed which would elapse on 06.02.2018.

No ground for anticipatory bail to the petitioners, as claimed, is made out in the light of the conduct of the petitioners.

The present petition, therefore, stands dismissed.
