Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in complaint case or FIR case is being lodged by respndent No.4, who is father in law of petitioner in counterblast to FIR No.5 dated 04.01.2018, registered under Sections 323, 498-A, 376, 506, 511 IPC got lodged by the petitioner against respondent No.4 and husband and mother in law of the petitioner.

Reply by way of a short affidavit of Alam Vijay Singh, PPS Deputy Superintendent of Police City 1, District SAS Nagar, Mohali on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 and 5 has been filed. Same is taken on record. Copy has been supplied.

As per the said reply, FIR No.41 dated 10.03.2018 has been

registered against the petitioner under Section 379 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the Criminal Misc.No.M-3580 of 2018 is also pending before the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court which has been referred to the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, the instant petition stands disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to seek appropriate remedy under law. However, in case the petitioner is to be arrested, she be served on three days prior notice.
