Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that even as per the disclosure statement made by a co-accused of the petitioner (Manish), on 06.05.2017, it was he who had conspired to and had kidnapped the deceased child, Aryan, with no other person stated to be involved either in the conspiracy or in the actual kidnapping.

Learned State counsel on instructions does not deny the fact that the aforesaid disclosure statement was made and submits that other than that, there is no evidence gathered by the police so far with regard to the case in question.

That being so, with no comment made on the actual merits of the aforesaid contentions, this petition is allowed and the petitioner, Sanjay, who is already stated to be in custody for about 9 ½ months now, is ordered to be admitted to bail, upon his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
