Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.73 dated 08.04.2017 registered under Sections 302/323/148/149 IPC at Police Station Cantonment, Amritsar.

In the initial statement of complainant Deepika, no role was assigned to the petitioner. In the supplementary statement of the complainant dated 10.04.2017, the petitioner was assigned a role of causing brick bat on the forehead of Shami.

The injury attributed to the petitioner was found to be simple in nature.

Apparently, petitioner has not caused any injury to Abhishek @ Janu. Co-accused Jyoti has already been granted regular bail in CRM-M No.31108 of 2017 on 25.09.2017. The statement of fact has not been denied by learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Avtar Singh assisted by learned counsel for the complainant.

Taking into consideration totality of facts and circumstances and without meaning anything on the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to enlarge the petitioner on regular bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
