Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in Criminal Appeal No.395 of 2017 filed in Complaint No.44 of 2015 dated 09.04.2015 under the Negotiable Instrument Act pending in the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur whereby the bail bond of the petitioner has been cancelled vide order dated 03.10.2018 (Annexure P-4).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that on 03.10.2018 when the appeal was listed before the lower appellate Court, petitioner could not appear before the court because of noting a wrong date, but at the same time, petitioner has already moved an application dated 30.07.2018 (Annexure P-5) showing his readiness to pay the disputed amount though with installments of Rs.5,000/- per month.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr.Rana Harjasdeep Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

Let a copy of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has shown his inclination to pay the outstanding amount during the pendency of appeal, present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner appears before the lower appellate Court within 10 days from today, the appellate Court shall admit him on bail subject to his furnishing fresh bail bonds/surety bonds to its satisfaction. The lower appellate Court is at liberty to impose any other condition as it may deem fit in the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case.
