Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0198 dated 09.10.2017 registered under Section 21 of NDPS Act, 1985 and Sections 379 and 411 of IPC at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that there is no other case against the petitioner and even in the present case, he was otherwise on bail but it is on account of his non-appearance on 26.07.2018, his bail bonds and surety bonds were cancelled and forfeited to the State. The alleged recovery is of 10 grams of heroine. There is a single default in appearance. Petitioner undertakes to appear before the trial Court regularly and shall not hamper/delay the trial in any manner.

At the asking of the Court, Mr.Rana Harjasdeep Singh, DAG,

Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Let a copy of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without observing anything on the merits of the case, present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner appears before the trial Court within 10 days from today, the trial Court shall admit him on bail, subject to his furnishing fresh bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. He shall also furnish an undertaking that neither he shall delay the proceedings in any manner nor will remain absent in the case.
