The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.331 dated 26.08.2018, under Sections 365, 34 of Indian Penal Code (Section 451 of IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioners herein contends that the petitioners were taken into custody in the aforesaid FIR on 26.08.2018. It is submitted that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present case. It is argued that the main allegations are against one Rajat, as named in the FIR. It is also contented that investigation is complete in the matter, as the challan has been presented and conclusion of trial will take sufficient time, therefore, the petitioners are entitled to be enlarged on bail.

Per contra, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent-State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, opposes the grant of regular bail to the petitioners. However, does not dispute the fact that investigation is complete and challan has been presented.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since, the trial is likely to take some time and in view of the facts that the petitioners herein have been in custody since 26.08.2018 and that investigation is complete in the matter, as the challan has been presented, no useful purpose would be served in keeping the petitioners behind bar. At this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed and the petitioners are directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
