The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No. 186 dated 23.11.2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 148, 149, 427, 447, 506 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3 of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, at Police Station Rajaund, District Kaithal.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that liability of the petitioner qua offence under Sections 3 of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 is debatable.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Subash Chander as well as counsel for the complainant submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and challan has been submitted.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the order dated 5.2.2018 is made absolute till the presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioners shall make themselves available for interrogation by the police as and when required;
- (ii) that the petitioners shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against them so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioners shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioners will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
