This is a petition that has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking to challenge the maintenance order dated 25.04.2017 that has been passed under Section 125 Cr.P.C. by the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Abohar, being high excessive as well as order dated 13.10.2017 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Fazilka whereby, the revision filed by the petitioner has been dismissed.

This court, while taking note of the contentions as raised by counsel for the petitioner, had directed the petitioner to deposit 50% of the amount due in two installments i.e. 25% of the maintenance amount was to be paid on 04.12.2017 and another 25% amount was to be deposited within a period of four weeks thereafter. The execution proceedings were directed to remain stayed till the next date of hearing, on deposit of the first installment.

This case is taken up for hearing today and learned counsel for the petitioner herein contends that there has been non-compliance of the interim order so passed.

In such a situation, this court is not inclined to entertain the instant petition and the same is hereby dismissed as such.
