In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for anticipatory bail under the provision of Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.133 dated 29.09.2018 registered under Section 420/120-B IPC at Police Station Kot Ise Khan District Moga.

2. Petitioner's bail application has been rejected on 11.10.2018 by Sessions Court while passing a detailed order.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner reiterating the contentions raised before the Sessions Court relating to matter is arising out of civil dispute between the complainant, petitioner and others. Co-accused has been extended bail by the Sessions Court. Thus, petitioner is also entitled.

4. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

5. Having regard to the agreement and role played by the petitioner to the extent of alleged to have cheated the complainant, petitioner has not made out a case so as to extend the concession of anticipatory bail.

6. Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
