The petitioner seeks issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 and 2 for protection of his life and liberty as he is being threatened by respondents No. 3 to 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that son of the petitioner was an accused in a criminal case. He was acquitted therefrom and because of this respondent No. 6 nursed a grudge. At her behest, respondents No. 3 to 5 are harassing him. He is being threatened to pay her money and he has also been made to sign some blank papers. A representation dated 12.10.2018 (Annexure P-1) has been submitted in this regard but the police is not taking any action thereupon till date.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

Mr. R.S. Bains, DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3. Let four copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to issue notices to respondents No. 4 to 6.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 2 to objectively consider the representation dated 12.10.2018 (Annexure P-1) and to

take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law, in case it is felt necessary,

within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
