Prayer in this application is for placing on record the death certificate of Jain Singh, who is stated to be the first husband of petitioner No.1.

Application is allowed. Death certificate of Jain Singh, is taken on record.

CRM-M-45340-2017

The petitioners have approached this Court seeking protection of their life and liberty on the premise that petitioner No.1 has performed marriage with petitioner No.2 against the wishes of her parents and other family members and the petitioners are apprehending threat to their life and liberty at their instance.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Rahul Rathore, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 3 – State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that a representation dated 26.11.2017 was made to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-4) seeking necessary protection but no action has been taken so far in the matter.

Heard.

Without examining the question of validity or otherwise of marriage of the petitioners, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, to look into grievance of the petitioners expressed in the representation dated 26.11.2017 (Annexure P-4) and take appropriate action, if any, warranted in the circumstances.

It is made clear that in case any FIR is registered against petitioner No.2, it will be open for the police authorities to take action in accordance with law.
