The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR
No. 139 dated 09.09.2018, under Sections 306/34 of the IPC, registered at
Police Station Urban Estate, Patiala.

The operative part of the order dated 17.10.2018, vide which
the petitioners have been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

**“Learned senior counsel for the petitioners
submits that petitioners are the parents of Major
Neeraj Yadav, who was married to Nikita Yadav, the
daughter of deceased Jagroop. It is further submitted
that on account of a matrimonial discord between the
son of the petitioners and his wife/daughter of the
deceased, Nikita Yadav was residing separately in her
parents' house.**

**Learned senior counsel further submits that the
petitioners are residing in Gurugram whereas their son
Major Neeraj Yadav is posted in Arunachal Pradesh
and his wife Nikita Yadav was staying in Patiala with
her parents where the deceased committed suicide.**

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners, in pursuance to the order dated 17.10.2018, have already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Shamsher Singh, assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 17.10.2018, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
