This is an application filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 60 dated 18.6.2018 (Annexure P-1) under Section 379-B of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Mehtiana, District Hoshiarpur.

The allegations against the present petitioner is of snatching of car on 17.6.2018. Petitioner was arrested on 11.7.2018 and is in custody since then.

Reply by way of affidavit of Daljit Singh Khakh, Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Hoshiarpur, on behalf of respondent-State filed in Court today is taken on record. As per the reply, out of four cases registered against the petitioner, he has been acquitted in one case; in one case he has been convicted and one FIR has been cancelled and one case is pending trial against the petitioner.

Considering that the petitioner is already in custody for the last 4½ months and conclusion of the trial will take time, no ground for further detention of the petitioner is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Petition stands allowed accordingly.
