Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Satnam Singh,
 submits that the petitioners have joined investigation and presently their
 custodial interrogation is not required.

Consequently, the interim orders dated 30.11.2017 and
 14.12.2017, passed in each of these petitions, are made absolute.

Since a lesser offence than the offence punishable under Section 307 IPC has subsequently been added, i.e. an offence punishable under Section 325 IPC, and the petitioners are not attributed any role as regards even the said offence as per the FIR, the orders granting bail to the petitioners in these petitions would also enure in respect of the offence subsequently added.
