Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that interim bail granted to the petitioner in two more cases *i.e.* CRM-M No.3247 of 2018 titled as Sanjay Tanwar Vs. State of Haryana and another decided on 08.05.2018 and CRM-M No.2090 of 2018 titled as Sanjay Tanwar Vs. State of Haryana and another decided on 08.05.2018, has been made absolute.
