Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.174 dated 30.08.2018 under Sections 379-B, 341, 323, 324, 149 IPC and Section 66(A) of the Information Technology Act, 2000 (the offence punishable under Section 379-B IPC and Section 66(A) of the Information Technology Act were deleted and the offence punishable under Sections 382, 355 IPC and Section 67 of the Information Technology Act were added subsequently), registered at Police Station Sadar Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel states that the petitioners are brother/cousin of Rajwinder Kaur alias Raju. They are in custody since 05.09.2018. Since the complainant has entered the house of the petitioners in their absence, it was the normal reaction of the petitioners.

On the other hand, learned State Counsel has argued that the

offences are serious.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioners are in custody since 05.09.2018 and the offence is triable by the Magistrate which may take a long time, this Court deems it appropriate to allow the present petition and to admit the petitioners on regular bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioners are admitted on regular bail, subject to furnishing of their bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
