Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.185 dated 17.09.2017 under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner was otherwise on bail, but it is on account of his non-appearance before the trial Court on 10.09.2018, his bail bonds have been cancelled and non-bailable warrants have been issued against him. The reason for his non-appearance was because of noting down a wrong date. However, the petitioner undertakes to appear before the trial Court.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Rana Harjasdeep Singh, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a week from today, he shall be admitted on bail on his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court, however, subject to payment of Rs.5,000/- as costs to be deposited by the petitioner with the District Legal Services Authority, Tarn Taran.

The trial Court may also impose any other condition upon the petitioner, as it may deem fit in the facts and circumstances of the case.
