ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 95 dated 22.07.2018, registered under Section 363, 366-A, 506 IPC, Section 6 of the POCSO Act and Section 3 of SC/ST Act, Women Police Station, Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody for over 3 months and it was a case of run away marriage and on return the girl refused to go to her parents and is lodged in the Nari Niketan. The counsel refers to the marriage certificate. It is also urged that the Aadhar Card placed on the record would show that the girl was major.

The girl had been recovered. She had preferred to go to the Nari Niketan. The trial would take time to conclude. Without commenting upon

the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
