By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions for proper investigation in respect of FIR No.258 dated 4.8.2016 registered under Section 346 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Pundri, District Kaithal.

The learned counsel submits that the husband of the petitioner went missing on 2.8.2016 regarding which the aforesaid FIR was lodged on 4.8.2016 but despite a period of more than two years have elapsed, no headway has been made for the investigation of the case.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Kaithal to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation (Annexure P-2) dated 10.11.2016 (although addressed to Director General of Police, Haryana Police Panchkula) moved by the petitioner, expeditiously in accordance with law and to ensure that the matter is fairly and expeditiously investigated and a final report is submitted at the earliest preferably within a period of three months from today. A copy of this order alongwith

representation (Annexure P-2) dated 10.11.2016 be sent to respondent No.3- Superintendent of Police, Kaithal so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
