Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondent No.3 to hold an independent enquiry in criminal complaint No.29/2016 dated 19.07.2016 registered under Sections 8/22/25/29/60 of NDPS Act.

After arguing the case for some time and in view of the fact that charges have been framed and the case is now fixed for prosecution evidence, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise all the pleas/defences during the course of trial.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has however submitted that since respondent No.7 Vodafone Punjab Telecom Circle as well as respondents No.5 & 9-BSNL have stated on 30.05.2018 that the call details have already been preserved, liberty may also be granted to the petitioner to summon the relevant record during the course of leading their defence evidence, in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
