Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jasvinder Singh states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required by the police.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that a condition should be imposed that the petitioner should not create any hindrance if excess land is reverted back.

In these circumstances, anticipatory bail granted on 27.11.2018 is made absolute subject to following conditions:-

1. The petitioner shall not commit any further offence.
2. She will not interfere in the due process of law
3. She will not leave country without prior permission of the Court
4. She will appear before investigating officer as and when directed.

The present petition is allowed accordingly.
