By this petition, quashing of FIR No.0072 dated 18.03.2016, is sought, registered against the petitioner at Police Station Tripuri, District Patiala, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 406/420/465/467/468/471 IPC (but charged under Sections 420/465/468 IPC), on the basis of a compromise arrived at between the petitioner (accused) and respondents no.2 and 3, with respondent no.2, being the complainant).

Vide orders of this Court dated 01.12.2017 and 16.01.2018, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded, in terms of the compromise.

Pursuant to the orders dated 01.12.2017 and 16.01.2018, the report of the learned JMIC, Patiala, dated 19.01.2018, has been received,

a perusal of which shows that the petitioner, Satvinder Singh Kang, as also

respondents no. 2 and 3, Zorawar Singh and Amandeep Singh, appeared before that Court and recorded their statements in favour of the compromise reached between them, with copies of the statements also having been annexed with the report. As per the assessment of the learned Magistrate, the compromise has been arrived at without any coercion and undue influence.

Learned State counsel on instructions submits that there is not other criminal case registered against the petitioner.

That being so and the allegations against the petitioner being that he had defrauded respondents no. 2 and 3, with respondent no.2 being the complainant in the FIR, the matter having been amicably settled between them, I see no purpose in continuing with criminal proceedings against the petitioner.

Consequently, the petition is allowed and FIR No.0072 dated 18.03.2016, registered against the petitioners at Police Station Tripuri, District Patiala, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 406/420/465/467/468/471 IPC (with the petitioner eventually charged under Sections 420/465/468 IPC), alongwith all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
