The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to petitioner-Deepak, in case FIR No.498 dated 20.08.2016 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 379-B, 365 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat.

It is a prosecution story that on 10th March, 2018 unknown desperadoes waylaid the complainant, they snatched away the car bearing registration No.DL-4CAE-5572, make Toyota Corrolla and also escaped along with an amount of Rs.6,000/-, one brief case containing documents, diary and keys of the complainant.

A country-made pistol and motorcycle have been recovered from the petitioner. He is in custody since 06.12.2017. Trial is in progress.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the court.
