The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.438 dated 21st June, 2017, registered under Sections 302, 341, 279-B, 120-B, 201, 506, 216, 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat.

On oral prayer of Ld. Counsel for the petitioner, let the typographical error in the second paragraph of Page 13 of the petition wherein offence has been mentioned as Section 279-B of

the IPC be corrected to Section 379-B of the IPC.

Considering the role attributed to the petitioner which is self-evident from the description given by the victim himself in the original FIR, there is little material to hold at this stage that he was involved in any conspiracy with a view to kill the victim.
