Through this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to petitioners in case FIR No.223, dated 01.09.2014 (P-1) under Sections 341, 323, 427, 506 & 34 IPC registered at Police Station City Jagraon, Ludhiana Rural, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that on single default of the petitioners on 17.09.2018 for non-appearance, their bail was cancelled, while dismissing their application seeking exemption of their personal appearance. Their bail bonds and surety bonds were forfeited to the State.

Considering order dated 17.09.2018 of the trial court, cancelling bail of the petitioners and order dated 08.10.2018 of Revisional Court, it is not a case, where concession of anticipatory bail can be granted to the petitioners.

Petitioners are directed to appear before the trial court within a week positively and their bail applications shall be decided within next seven days. In case, petitioners are granted bail, they shall furnish undertaking apart from other conditions so to be imposed by the trial court on them that in future they would not commit a single default of their absence and would also not move any application for their personal exemption.
