The petitioner claims that she is being evicted from her matrimonial house by her in-laws after death of her husband. The civil Court has granted an injunction in her favour, yet she is being harassed by them and the police has failed to take any action despite representation dated 07.09.2018 (Annexure P-3).

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 4 only.

Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4. Let five copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to issue notices to respondents No. 5 to 15.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 2 to objectively consider the representation dated 07.09.2018 (Annexure P-3) and to take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law, in case it is felt necessary, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
