ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 32 dated 26.03.2018, registered under Section 376(2)(N) and 506 IPC, Women Police Station, Panipat, District Panipat.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the complaint was lodged by a married woman who had not legally obtained divorce and it was a live in relationship and allegations of rape have now been levelled. The counsel refers to the complaint filed by the complainant under the Domestic Violence Act.

The petitioner is in custody since 30.03.2018. Challan has already been presented. The trial would take long time to conclude. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the

petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
