Present petition has been filed for seeking bail pending trial in FIR No.21 dated 21.02.2018 for the offences punishable under Section 302/34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act (Sections 212/216/120-B IPC added subsequently), registered at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that even as per the case of prosecution, the petitioner is not involved in the incident, at the stage of commission of the murder. The only allegation against the petitioner is that after having committed the murder, the main accused left the motorcycle and the pistol used in the crime, with the petitioner, which was allegedly recovered, later on, by the police from the petitioner. It is, thus, contended that in view of the above, the petitioner cannot be

held liable for the offence punishable under Section 302 IPC. The petitioner is in custody since 11.07.2018. Challan has been filed. There is no other case against the petitioner.

On the other hand learned State counsel, being instructed by ASI Hera Singh, submits that recovery has been effected from the house of petitioner, so he is found involved in the incident.

Keeping in view the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, but without commenting any further on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is granted the concession of bail pending trial. He be released on bail pending trial, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
