Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 01.12.2017, the petitioner appeared before the trial Court and has been granted ad interim bail.

A perusal of that order of this Court shows that such bail was granted conditional upon the receipt of the report of the chemical examiner before the trial Court.

Learned State counsel has produced in Court a photocopy of the report of the chemical examiner, though it is not given in that copy as to whether the quantity recovered from the petitioner was commercial or non-commercial.

Consequently, this petition is allowed with a direction to the petitioner to now appear before the trial Court on 18.01.2018, i.e. the date already fixed before that Court, with the trial Court to thereafter proceed on the basis of the laboratory report and other factors which it wishes to take

into consideration, for granting/refusing bail to the petitioner.
