The petitioner herein has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 85 dated 5.3.2018, under Sections 363, 366-A, 354, 376, 511, 34, 120-B IPC and Section 12 of the POCSO Act registered at Police Station Rai, District Sonapat.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case and he is in custody since 8.6.2018. It is also contended that investigation is complete, challan presented and charges have been framed. No custodial interrogation is required. The trial is likely to take some time. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind bars till the conclusion of the trial.

He prays that the petitioner be admitted to regular bail.

Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, learned AAG, Haryana has contested the bail application while submitting that the charges levelled against the petitioner are of serious nature and as such he does not deserves the concession of regular bail.

Without going into the merits of the case and keeping in view the facts that challan has been presented, charges have been framed and the trial is likely to take some time to conclude, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
